### STATEMENT OF COMMITMENT "ICI ON RECYCLE! "

May 5<sup>th</sup> 2008 - The president of DCM Aerospace signed a statement of commitment to promote the management of residual materials within its establishment.

Seeking to reduce its environmental impact and recognizing the importance of a healthy residual materials management, DCM Aerospace has thus committed to take cognizance of the Quebec residual materials management Policy 1998-2008, to identify residual materials generated in its establishment, to put in place measures to manage residual materials in accordance with the principle of 4R-D (source reduction, reuse, recycling, resource recovery and disposal) and finally to communicate the commitment to its employees and make them aware of the policy and to a responsible management of residual materials.

It was at the suggestion of Mr. Jonathan E. Travers, an employee of DCM Aerospace since 2003 that the company has accepted the invitation of *Recyc-Quebec* to embark on a program called "Ici on Recycle!" ([www.recyc-quebec.gouv.qc.ca](http://www.recyc-quebec.gouv.qc.ca))

This commitment will support the broad objectives that the company has given itself thus to develop and maintain a culture of pro-health, safety and environment contributing to the welfare of its staff and surrounding community.
